### **BACKGROUND OF THE LITURGY**

#### **GENERAL THEME:**

Last week we pondered blessings and woes. Today we consider the command "Love your enemies." This command sounds forbidding. In fact, carrying out this command is guaranteed to shake up a social order which needs shaking.

Abundance of blessing is to be expected as we heed this command of Jesus: "Love your enemies." When we have been unheeding, our God still loves us. We open ourselves to deeper friendship with God.

#### FIRST READING: 1 Samuel 26:2, 7-9, 12-13, 22-23

Saul, the first king of Israel, is envious of David, whom the crowds acclaim as a potential leader. David may be able to do away with Saul and claim the kingship. But he is guided by a sense of Saul's dignity.

<u>SECOND READING: 1 Corinthians 15:45-49</u>
St. Paul properly calls Jesus "the last Adam." Whereas Adam succumbed to sin, Jesus demonstrated what humanity can be like when freed from sin. The sinless one has set us free from all that could alienate us from ourselves.

#### **GOSPEL READING: Luke 6:27-38**

Today we hear the "golden rule," although Jesus does not give this title to it. Doing what we would expect from others certainly makes sense. But going so far as to love our enemies? Jesus gives us this challenge. We expect good to come from it.


