#### BACKGROUND OF THE LITURGY

#### **GENERAL THEME:**

Knowing, understanding, is not to be equated with looking at a picture of something. For understanding goes deeper than images. We are aided by the Son of God, whom human eyes have seen, and by the mystery of God, which cannot be pictured.

We all know that we can be very presumptuous, supposing that we see a truth which others have not adopted. Yet there are many things which we cannot see. We turn to our God that we may be enlightened.

#### FIRST READING: Joshua 5:9a, 10-12

The children of Israel set foot upon the land which God promised to them. We make a connection with the festivities in today's Gospel, and we feel a sense of thanksgiving for God's gifts of food and drink.

**SECOND READING: 2 Corinthians 5:17-21** We may find Paul's statement, "he made him to be sin who did not know sin," to be puzzling. We must understand that he is speaking of how Jesus bore the weight of all our sins upon himself.

#### GOSPEL READING: Luke 15:1-3, 11-32

Are we unnerved by Jesus' strange parable, in which absurd things happen? Out of the trio of the father and his two sons, with whom do we identify? Is there a meanness within ourselves which this parable is addressing?
