BACKGROUND OF THE LITURGY

GENERAL THEME:

As the moon marked the time for the Passover and the liberation of the children of Israel, so the moon gives us the time each year for our Easter celebration. We are liberated from sin and freed to be fully alive.

Today marks the resurrection of Jesus. It is also the feast of our incorporation into the tery of Jesus' death and resurrection. Holy Week puts us in touch with Jesus' death; may we proceed to deeper confidence that he has united himself with all of us.

FIRST READING: Acts 10:34a, 37-43

Peter professes that the apostles ate and drank with Jesus after he rose from the dead. Jesus' resurrection meant that he was himself as they knew him before his death. This fact helps us with our belief in "the resurrection of the body."

<u>SECOND READING: Colossians 3:1-4</u> "For you have died." Colossians calls us to understand that, in our baptism, we have actually died with Jesus as he died. Then we also rose with him just as he is risen from death.

GOSPEL READING: John 20:1-9

Two of Jesus' disciples run to his open, empty tomb. They had no expectation of a resurrection. But they looked at the way the burial cloths were strewn about, and they remembered what Jesus said would happen.


